# The Environment Fund Administration (EFA)

#### Who we are

A specialized institution of the central public administration, responsible for collecting and managing the Environment Fund, with legal personality, coordinated with the Ministry of Environment, Water and Forest.

#### What we do

Support the funding of 26 national, environment programme categories.

#### **Role within EEA Grants**

Programme Operator of RONDINE Programme for Renewable Energy in Romania, with a total grant value of € 13,250,000 to support both hydro and geothermal projects.





# The programme aimed at increasing the production of energy from renewable sources

**2008 - 2014** 33 implemented projects, with a settled grant value of 294,228,325.78 lei (over **€ 65 million**) for wind, biomass, hydro, photovoltaic, biogas and geothermal.

#### **Hydro only**

**2010 - 2014** 4 commissioned projects, for a total grant value of 54.220.673,01 lei (about € **12 million**)





# RO 06 Renewable Energy Programme (RONDINE)

#### 2 financed components, hydropower and geothermal:

The hydropower component – € 6,625,000

The geothermal component – € 6,625,000

**The hydropower component** aims at achieving initial investment and refurbishment of hydropower plants.

**The geothermal component** aims at achieving initial investments and reengineering of the thermal energy production plants that use geothermal energy.

## **Eligibility**

On the hydropower component - eligible applicants are public and private commercial entities

On the geothermal component - eligible applicants are public and private commercial entities, and local administrative units/authorities

#### **Grant Rate:**


**For public or private commercial entities** the grant is up to maximum 50% of total eligible value of the project, and for Bucharest-Ilfov region it is allocated maximum 40% of total eligible value of the project.

**For local administrative units/authorities** the grant is up to 100% of total eligible value of the project.


