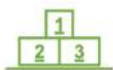

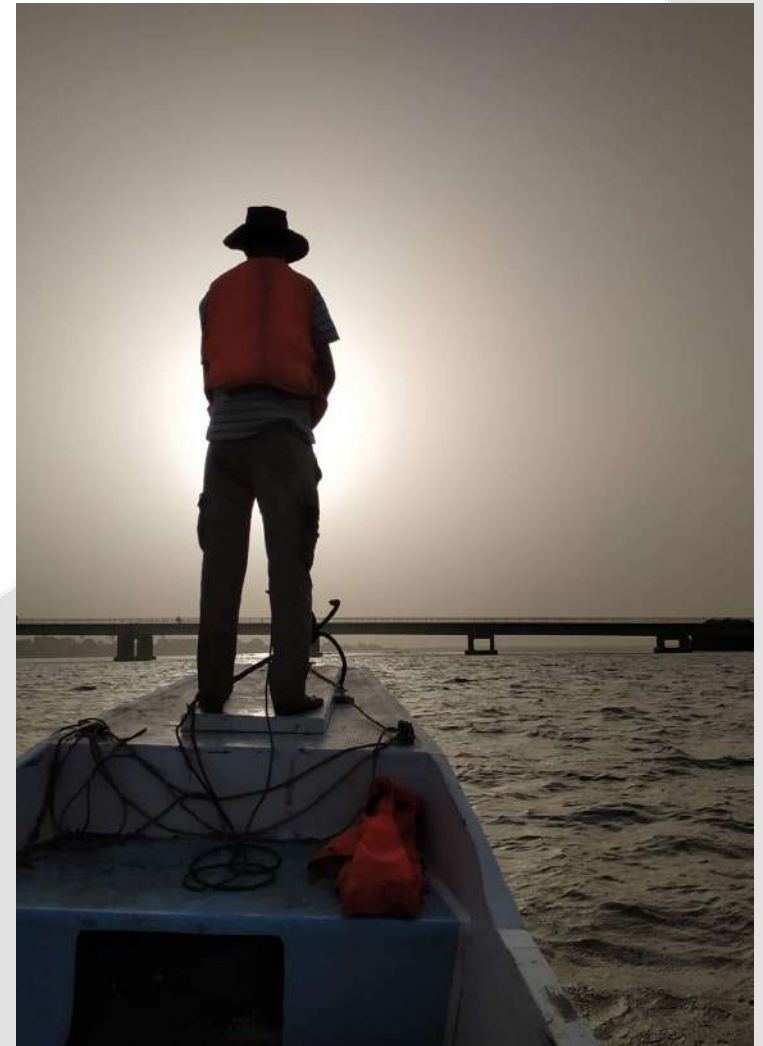

BANK SECTOR & SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS




Analysis : Major funds and banks do not lend money to fossil fuel projects.

Request : Mexican banks want to analyse the impacts of their investments in term of sustainability and social aspects

First solution: ALLCOT set up a workshop for a group of banks in Mexico

Purpose: Need to measure the social aspects and environmental impacts of the projects looking for loans / investments.

Feedback : Bank sector start to anticipate the SDG impacts and see it as a risk for their investment.



BEST PRACTICE : SANTA MARTA



Santa Marta landfill is an existing and operational landfill site. It is located 17 Km south of Santiago city.

The site is suitable for municipal solid waste management and it is one of the most important landfills in the region. The activity involves the collection and utilization of the LFG for generation of electricity. This landfill gas would have been released into the atmosphere in the absence of the project.
